Getting Started

Placing an Order

1. First, navigate to the treatment plan and open up new orders.
2. Search for Myriad Oncology and the order form will open up.
3. Indicate whether you would like to order germline and/or tumor genomic tests for your patient from the test selection.
 - a. Select a single panel from the germline test options and all tumor genomic tests that apply from the options listed that you would like to order.
 - b. Only eligible order fields and test options will be available based on the panel selected.
4. In the next section, you will enter your patient's relevant clinical history and their family history of cancer. The required fields are denoted by an asterisk.
5. For patients that have been diagnosed with cancer, you will also fill in the patient history of cancer section.
 - a. Any clinical data available in the patient chart will auto-populate here and will be noted by the blue icon next to the field.
6. When ordering germline testing for select female patients, you will also be prompted to include RickScore® and Tyrer-Cusick for a Breast cancer risk assessment.
7. Complete the required specimen information for both germline and tumor genomic tests.
8. Complete the required specimen collection information and method for both germline and tumor genomic tests.
 - a. For tumor testing, indicate whether you will arrange for specimen shipment or if you'd like Myriad to manage tissue collection. At this step attach a pathology report associated with the sample.
9. Complete the billing section, agree to the attestation and sign to successfully submit the order.

Order Status and Results

1. Once your order is successfully submitted, a new row called Myriad Oncology will appear on the patient chart.
 - a. You can click on it to see a read-only version of the ordering form and print it to include with your requisition order.
2. View the order status (Submitted or Reported) directly from the patient's treatment plan under Myriad Oncology.

3. All orders are also displayed on the Specimen Collection Record to inform your lab which samples need to be collected.
4. When results are ready, they will be automatically delivered to the ordering provider's inbox for quick visibility and accessible via the treatment plan.

To track the status of orders and view results across patients, use Shared Views in the Prior Authorization and Scheduling Group Inbox and set up filters. Additionally, practices can run the "Myriad Order Status Report" to view orders in a specific status.
